

NEED STATEMENT: STUDY BIBLES

DESCRIPTION: The Gospel Center Rescue Mission's (GCRM) has developed a model for success for every individual who enters our program. Within that model is an educational curriculum which enhances the lives of our residents or students and offers several tools and skills to prepare them for re-entry into society. The key study book common for all of our life-changing programs to Graduation and beyond is a Bible. GCRM is standardized its Bible version so all Teachers and Students are working off the same Bible version. The Celebrate Recovery Bible is the standardized Ministry Bible that GCRM has selected. GCRM requires approximately 250 Bibles for the next twelve months of teachers and students. **Note that part of this amount is to ramp up for the 118 additional New Life Program women in 2020 with the renovation of the former Alustiza Hotel and Restaurant.**

BENEFIT: As most of our Program Students attend Celebrate Recovery (CR) and will continue to attend CR or a similar program after Graduation, the CR Bible has been chosen by GCRM. The hard copy study version allows for our Students to study the Bible and maintain a longer usage lifespan. Our curriculum contains courses which are all supported by the student's own Celebrate Recovery Bible.

GCRM provides the following programs for those in need living in San Joaquin County:

- Emergency lodging for over 100 men, women and their children each night.
- Representative payee services for approximately 600 clients.
- Recuperative care services for up to 24 clients.
- Up to 500 hot meals and 1,500 cold meals (sandwiches & breakfast meals) each day - 365 days/year.
- GED preparation, job readiness and search, and housing search programs.
- Case management for medical, housing, children, and other social issues.
- Extended programs that can be up to 2 years in addiction recovery, life skills and transition to work leading to life transformation.
- Free Clothing & furniture Ministry to the homeless and needy.
- Disaster Refugee Relief in the event of a natural or terrorism disaster in San Joaquin County.
- Free non-profit training in our program areas.
