NEED STATEMENT: DISASTER REFUGEE RELIEF PROGRAM FUND

DESCRIPTION: Should an earthquake, fire, flood or other natural disaster or terrorism event occur in San Joaquin County, the Gospel Center Rescue Mission can accommodate for several weeks up to 50 refugees where lodging, food and clothing are provided. When refugees return to new housing, the Mission can further assist with furniture through its free furniture outreach to the Community. This Program is in addition to its current overnight Men's Emergency Lodge and New Hope Family Shelter Program for 100 men, women and children.

BENEFIT: GCRM stands ready to be a leader in homeless solutions for San Joaquin County. This Program is just another example of this commitment.



COST: \$20,000/year requirement for an estimated 1 occurrence.
