NEED STATEMENT: NEW LIFE PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS

DESCRIPTION: The Gospel Center Rescue Mission's (GCRM) provides a free, residential recovery and life skills program. Our residents, or “Students,” are people who have lost control of their lives as a result of drugs and/or alcohol which in most cases has resulted in homelessness. **But, there is hope!** The New Life Program is a 2 year regeneration program to transition the student from addiction to recovery for men and women providing classes, work therapy, and positive activities in the San Joaquin County community. Note that student’s children are housed as well on campus



COST: \$5,000/student’s first or second 6 month program requirement.

RECOGNITION & STEWARDSHIP: Scholarship donor can have the maximum interaction within the donor’s comfort level and within the campus/program rules that apply to the student. Here are some interaction examples:

- Receipt of an initial letter from their scholarship student.
- An invitation to their student’s graduation & be listed on the Graduation Program.
- Donor can invite their student to their church. (But must pick-up and return the student.)
- Donor can have lunch with their student on campus.
- Other student interaction subject to student’s privileges.
