The "Sing For THEIR Supper" Karaoke Fundraising Event is a fun way for singers (and non-singers alike) to perform for meals served to the homeless at the Gospel Center Rescue Mission every day. "Sing For THEIR Supper" performers are invited to ask family, friends, co-workers or members of your church, club, group, business or organization to pledge donations for meals with each performance. You will have the opportunity to perform from a selection of thousands of songs 'live' on stage at the Downtown Farmer's Market!
